February 2006: This male yew grows south of the church. A large pile of combustible material was stored beneath its branches. Climbing over the hazard it was possible to find that the tree has hollows with some internal growth. At each end of the elongated bole were large and complex areas of growth. In the centre was a small platform at a height of about 5'/6'. Girth was obtained with difficulty and 19' 2" was recorded at its narrowest close to the ground.





In 2014 Peter Norton recorded a girth of 19' 3" close to the ground.

In November 2016 the ground had been cleared making it possible to properly appreciate this fine tree. Girth was 19' 4" at or close to the ground.





In 2016 a second yew, female, was recorded. It grows NE of the church and is twin trunked from low down with a girth of 10'/11'.
